




Let's use the touchpad



On a laptop, you'll use a touch pad instead of a mouse.


If you're right handed, you'll use your right hand.
If you're left handed, you'll use your left hand.





When you move the touchpad, the cursor will move in the same direction on the screen.
The cursor is the arrow on the screen.



Let's move the cursor using the touchpad




To move the cursor, gently slide your index finger on the touchpad.
Your cursor will move the same way on the screen.



When you're using the touchpad, you'll only need to use the tip of your finger.



Let's practice!



Let's practice moving the mouse. Try moving the cursor...

1. To the top left corner **1** of the screen.
2. To the middle **2** of the screen.
3. To the bottom right corner **3** of the screen.
4. To the bottom left corner **4** of the screen.





How to left-click




The left button on the touchpad is used to make a left-click.
When you want to select something on your screen, use the left-click.
You can also gently tap the touchpad.






How to click and drag

Hey,


Briefly take over the computer and go to: <http://www.abcya.com/pizza.htm>
It's a game that your adult learner can play to practice using the mouse.

In this game we're going to make a pizza. You'll use the touchpad to add toppings onto the pizza. To begin the game, click the Go button.




First, let's add sauce to the pizza. Click on the sauce button **1** and then click which type of pizza sauce you want **2** or **3**.

To add sauce to the pizza, left-click on the pizza **4** with your left index finger. Don't lift your finger. Then put your right index finger on the touchpad and move it all around the pizza. When you're done, lift your fingers off the touchpad.



Now let's add some toppings. Let's start with cheese. To put cheese on your pizza, click and hold on the cheese you want, and drag it on top of the pizza. After you move the cheese on top of the pizza, let go of the left-click button.



Can you add more toppings to your pizza? Try adding some meat and vegetables.






When you're finished, click Cook so that we can cook the pizza.



When your pizza is ready, you can left-click anywhere on the pizza to eat it. Try eating the entire pizza.


